It is the responsibility of the property owner for the upkeep of the boulevards to maintain the current state, whether it is grass, dirt, or gravel/rock.

- a. If there is grass, ensure it is mowed.
- b. If there is dirt or gravel/rock, ensure that it is weed free.
- c. Ensure debris is not put on the streets.
