Motorists please be mindful of the Town speed limits. Complaints have been received at the Office regarding motorists using excessive speed throughout Town Limits.

Town speed limit is 40 km and 30 km in school zones.

STAYING SAFE IN THE HEAT

Extreme heat events can lead to heat-related illnesses that occur when the body overheats. This is caused by prolonged exposure to high temperatures.

If heat-related illness occurs, below are ways to help reduce your body temperature:

- Take off extra layers of clothing and expose the skin.
- Drink cool water and drink regularly, even when not thirsty.
- Place damp towels in plastic bags and put them in the fridge, and apply them to the body regularly.
- Take cool showers.
- Fill a spray bottle with cool water for misting.
- Limit physical activity and exposure to the outdoors during the hottest hours.

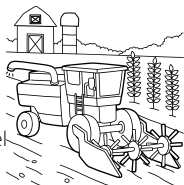
