As a reminder, taxes are due November 30. Taxes not paid by this date are subject to a penalty automatically applied on December 1, 2023. Penalties will not be waived. The Town continues to accept cash, cheques, e-transfers, postdated cheques, pre-authorized payments (PAP) and online payments.
