TRANSFER STATION/FORMER LANDFILL

There appears to be confusion amongst residents about use of the former landfill. As previous, residents may still take larger household items that don't fit into the carts. It is now referred to as a Transfer Station because that's exactly what it is ... refuse taken there is picked up by Loraas and *transferred* to the Regional landfill site. Our landfill attendant will direct you on where to place your refuse. **Our Transfer Station remains open as previous – every Tuesday morning and the first and third Saturday morning each month with the same user fees in place.**

ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

With the arrival of spring, we will once again be enjoying our motorized toys! Residents are reminded these are off road vehicles and as such, are to be used in accordance to the All-Terrain Vehicles Act. Riders must wear an approved helmet, appropriate riding gear, and the driver have a valid driver's license or as provided for by the ATV Act. Please drive safely.

ASSESSMENT ROLL

The assessment roll be open the middle of March. As a reminder the assessed value of your property is used to determine the tax amount that is levied. With 2021 being a provincial re-evaluation year, each property is anticipated to change to reflect the January 2019 base date. When the roll is open, for 60 days, you are welcome to make an appointment to have a discussion with the Administrator regarding your assessment and the tax implications that it will have. We anticipate that an assessor from SAMA will spend an afternoon at the Town Office to be available for any questions you may have. Once we have a date finalized, we will publicize the date and take appointments.
