If you plan to set off fireworks, you are required to contact the Town Office first.

BUDGET AND TAXES

Shortly, Council will be reviewing our 2021 budget. Once again there will be some tough decisions that will need to be made regarding the finances of our community. Changes to tax policy is something that is never taken lightly. To accommodate infrastructure challenges including street paving, sidewalk replacement, replacement of old equipment, tree removal and replacement, water, sewer and lagoon upgrades, long term planning and mandatory changes to the landfill, a carefully thought-out plan will be created that is conscientious of the financial challenges that continue to exist due to the pandemic.
