ORDER TO REMEDY

Bylaw No. 2005-03 Nuisances Abatement states that no person shall cause or permit a nuisance to occur on any property owned by that person. Furthermore, no owner or occupant of land shall cause or permit the land to be overgrown with grass or weeds. Moreover, no person shall cause or permit any junked vehicle to be kept on any land owned by that person.

Rain has caused weed and grass growth throughout our community. Over the next coming weeks, the Town will be sending registered letters to property owners with nuisances that need to be remedied. Residents are encouraged to maintain their boulevards as well and try to keep them free of weeds, overrun grass, and ruts.


WE ARE HIRING
