DEVELOPMENT APPEALS BOARD

The Town is seeking residents to put their names forward to be on the development appeals board.

The function of a DAB is to hear appeals where an appellant disagrees with certain development-related decisions made by a municipality. In its role as an adjudicator, a development appeals board is expected to be fair and impartial. Examples of appeals include requests for minor variances to the standards of the zoning bylaw, misapplication of the zoning bylaw, and wrongful refusal of a development permit.
