PURPOSE:

To clearly define the obligations of the property owners and the Town of Lemberg.

POLICY:

- 1. It is the responsibility of the property owner for the upkeep on the boulevards, maintained the current state whether it is grass, dirt, or gravel/rock.
 - a. If there is grass, ensure it is mowed.
 - b. If there is dirt or gravel/rock, ensure that it is weed free.
 - c. Ensure debris is not put on the streets.
- 2. If the property owner wants to plant grass this does not need to be approved by Council, anything other than planting grass needs prior Council approval.
- 3. If the trees on the boulevard need to be trimmed contact the town office. This will be looked at on a case by case basis. Some factors that are considered but not limited to are:
 - a. Is it causing a public safety hazard?
 - b. Is it aesthetics or cause damage to the yard, sidewalks, or streets?
 - c. What type of tree is it?
