

BYLAW 4/2009

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LEMBERG TO ESTABLISH A
TRUCK ROUTE.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Lemberg in the Province of
Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1) No person shall drive a heavy vehicle on any street or portion of a street
Except as set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.
The streets or portions thereof as set out in Schedule "A" are hereby
Established as heavy vehicle routes.
 - (a) Provided that this subsection shall not apply to any persons operating a heavy
Vehicle owned by the Town of Lemberg while actually in use in the service of
The Town.
 - (b) An provided further that this subsection shall not apply to heavy vehicles being
Operated for the collection or delivery of goods within the Town limits. However,
Heavy vehicles proceeding to or from a point of collection or delivery shall proceed
To or from such a point by or to the nearest heavy vehicle route.
 - (c) And provided further that this subsection shall not apply to heavy vehicles
Proceeding to and from the business premises or residence of the owner or
Driver of such heavy vehicle.
 - (d) An provided further that this subsection shall not apply to heavy vehicles proceeding
To or from a garage for the purpose of repairs.
- 2) For the purpose of this section "heavy vehicles" shall mean a motor vehicle with or
Without load which alone or together with any trailer, semi-trailer or other vehicle
Being towed weights 10,000 kilograms or more, or a motor vehicle which together
With trailer, semi-trailer or other vehicle being towed exceeds 10 1/2 meters in
Total length.
- 3) No person shall park or permit to stand motionless, any truck, motor vehicle or other
Vehicle whatsoever that is specifically designed to convey, carry or transport
Gasoline, liquid or gaseous petroleum products or liquid or gaseous chemical
Products of any kind in a capacity of one thousand, one hundred and fifty (1,150)
Litres or more, whether in a tank or tanks, barrel or barrels or any other receptacle
Or receptacles whatsoever within the town limits, except on any railway company
Premises and on the business premises of the owner of any such vehicle provided
That the owner thereof is a distributor or transporter of the petroleum or chemical
Product and owns or leases or permits anyone to occupy the said business premises.
This section does not apply to any oil, gasoline or other fuels as may be required
For the vehicles own motive power and stored in a tank or tanks connected to the
Engine of such vehicle, nor does this section apply to the time during which any such
Vehicle is necessarily allowed to stand motionless while delivering gasoline, fuel,
Oil or chemical product to garages, pumps or retail dealers in, or private consumers
Of the products, nor does it apply to the time during which the driver of the vehicle
Has left the vehicle to have any meal at an eating establishment in a Highway
Commercial or Industrial Area of the Town.
- 4) Anyone who contravenes this Bylaw shall be subject to the Town of Lembergs Penalty
Bylaw 4/86.

THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO EFFECT ON THE DATE OF PASSING.

SCHEDULE "A"

THE DESIGNATED TRUCK ROUTE SHALL BE
THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) Martin Street from Highway 22 North to Railway Ave.
- 2) Golling Street from Highway 22 North to Railway Ave.

There are to be no "Heavy Trucks" going down Main Street from
Highway 22 North to Railway Ave.
