## Municipal By-Election

The Municipal By-Election for the Town of Lemberg transpired on Thursday, February 25th, with a commendable turnout of 107 voters exercising their civic duty to fill two vacant positions on the Town Council.

We are pleased to announce the successful candidates, Mr. Todd Poier and Mr. Don Taylor, who emerged as the newly elected members of the Council.

The induction ceremony, wherein both individuals will solemnly take their Oath/Affirmation as members of the Council, is scheduled to transpire during a special meeting of Council set for February 8th, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. Following this ceremonial undertaking, they will duly assume their respective seats on Council, serving for the remaining term of office.

We extend our sincere congratulations to Mr. Poier and Mr. Taylor, expressing confidence in their ability to contribute significantly to the continued prosperity of our community.

## New Online Water Meter Reading Submission Form

The Town of Lemberg has a new additional way to send in your water meter readings to the Town.

You can go online to our website and click on Resident Services>Water & Sewer>Water Meter Reading Submission.

Here you will find a form that you can enter in your water meter reading and we will receive it at the Office to use for your monthly utility bill.

We will always continue to accept telephone calls/messages and email submissions but we are working on ways to provide residents with more convenient ways of getting your water meter reading into the Office.

## Snow Removal Policy (Adopted March 15, 2022)

Snow and Ice Control priorities are subject to change based on circumstances surrounding a particular snowfall at Public Works Foreman’s discretion. Snow and Ice Control priorities following the end of a typical snow event shall be as follows in Schedule “A”:

Priority One: Red Area (*Main Street, Truck Routes, and emergency vehicle access*)

Priority Two: Green Area (*The remainder of Town Streets*)

Priority Three: Purple Area (*Alleyways*)

Priority Four: Blue Area (*If time permits*)

Vehicles, trailers, and any other items stored or otherwise parked are encouraged to be removed from streets before 7:00 a.m. for proper snow and ice controls from October 1st to April 30th. Vehicles in regular use (used every day) may not be parked on the street for periods longer than 72 hours.

Snow and Ice placed on municipal streets, sidewalks, pathways, or Municipal Facilities by individuals or companies will not be permitted.




